Guest Celebrant Practices and Policies

As guest Clergy of the Chapel, it is understood that you will follow the Massachusetts guidelines to ensure you are appropriately licensed to perform a marriage ceremony. The licensing can take months to accomplish. It is also your responsibility to have read through the information contained on our website pertaining to WEDDINGS at the SIASCONSET UNION CHAPEL (sconsetchapel.org/weddings). We respectfully ask that you agree to comply with our stated and implied practices and policies.

While the Chapel's Wedding Hospitality Coordinator or the Catholic Wedding Coordinator will be glad to meet with you to familiarize you with the Chapel, the rehearsal is yours to manage. The Coordinators are skilled with the limits and possible movements of the bridal couple and attendants in the Chapel. On the wedding day they will assist the bridal party with their entrance. They are also aware of the regulations regarding flowers, photography and videography. Rely on them for the local use and wisdom within the chapel. You will want to clarify your signals for the groom's party to enter.

It is also our anticipation that any approved Protestant clergy will offer pre-marital counseling suited to his or her tradition. If you are unable to offer this care, please speak to the Rev. J. Carr Holland, III, minister of the Chapel.
